

# Guide for Sofa-fabrics

1. This guide is for KELVIN GIORMANI sofa users to deal with normal household stains on sofa-fabrics. It can be applied to all fabric articles from KELVIN GIORMANI sofa-fabric collection, and the following demonstration is done with AIRONE.



2. The cleaning kit that we recommend for sofa-fabrics is FABRIC CLEANING KIT from “RENZO”, made in Italy.

3. Like other care kits that are provided to household consumers by virtually all sofa brands, this FABRIC CLEANING KIT is meant for making normal household stains less visible on sofa-fabric surface but not for completely removing them; nevertheless, the earlier the stains are dealt with, the better the stain removal results are.
4. For normal household stains from, such as, coffee, wine, sauce or grease, etc., they shall be first wiped dry from the fabric sofa surface by the small foam sponge. Please wash up the foam sponge by clear water when it gets too dirty before continuing to use it in order to avoid the dirt from transferring back to the fabric sofa.

5. Next, pick up the FABRIC CLEANER.
6. Spray it onto the stain mark.
7. Use the small brush to gently brush (preferably in a circular motion) the sprayed area of the fabric sofa.

8. Then, use the dry white cloth to wipe the brushed area of the fabric sofa in order to transfer the stain-dirts to the white cloth; when it gets too dirty, please wash it with clear water in order to avoid the dirts from transferring back to the fabric sofa.
9. Afterwards, repeat this “wiping” process (can be more than once) to improve the stain removal result.

10. Finally, use a hair-drier to blow-dry the treated area of the fabric sofa.



11. Please resume to use the sofa after the treated area is fully dried.

12. When it comes to tough stains, the FABRIC STAIN REMOVER can be used. It shall be applied with the same steps and sequence as in the FABRIC CLEANER.
